Outputs	Working in partnership with all relevant agencies we will improve the investigation and resolution of complaints of anti-social behaviour and seek to support initiatives, which will reduce the levels of harassment and intimidation within our communities. Continue our support for mediation and reparation services to resolve conflicts and disputes. Promote positive and healthy alternatives to our communities to encourage socially responsible behaviour.

We will also promote the use of dog bins and work with communities to identify new locations where required. Take cognisance of New Legislation and consider how best to utilise and implement the changes to the benefit of the community.

Lead Agency	Aberdeenshire Council
Partner Agencies	Grampian Police, Grampian Fire and Rescue Service, Crimestoppers, Community Safety Groups, BT Police
Outputs	We will work with partners to support locally based initiatives in order to reduce vandalism in our communities. Promote and develop procedures to expedite the removal of abandoned vehicles and formalise policy in relation to the removal of combustible material in order to reduce fire hazards. We will seek to improve street lighting to reduce crime or fear of crime and also support national and local initiatives to tackle the misuse of fireworks and support the BT Hoax Call initiative to reduce malicious emergency calls. Support will be given to the multi agency CCTV Tasking and Liaison Group to deter acts of vandalism and wilful fireraising.

Key Task 4	Promote Water and Sea Cliff Safety
Lead Agency	Maritime and Coastguard Agency
Partner Agencies	Aberdeenshire Council, Community Safety Groups
Outputs	Working with partner agencies we will provide cliff, beach and sea safety education together with risk analysis based safety initiatives for the benefit of schools, communities and members of the public using the sea and coast for leisure purposes. Advise and encourage the public to report hazardous objects and debris found on beaches for appropriate disposal. The partnership will be represented on the SAPC Water and Leisure Safety Committees.
