Outputs	Promote multi agency working to reduce incidents of domestic abuse and support specialist services that tackle alcohol and drug problems related to domestic abuse. We will promote and assist all agencies that provide victim support and also encourage work with the perpetrators of domestic violence to reduce repeat offending. Continue our support of the Domestic Abuse Multi Agency Group.

Continue to support the Neighbourhood Watch Scheme and promote environmental and physical security. Vulnerable groups will be identified and supplied with appropriate crime prevention advice and tools. We will assist all agencies that provide victim support. Using the Police National Intelligence Model vulnerable communities will be proactively targeted with advice and support.
